




Routing of brake hoses on front axle, vehicles with 4MATIC

Routing of brake hoses on rear axle, all models

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Do not completely drain brake fluid supply reservoir to prevent air from getting into the brake system. If drained completely, it is necessary to bleed the entire brake system (special bleeding procedure required for vehicles with ASR).

Brake lines (5 and 6) unscrew, screw on at brake hose (51). Use open box wrench 9 × 11. Counterhold brake hose (51) with open-end wrench. Seal off brake lines (5 and 6) immediately with blind plugs.

torques:

Brake hose (51)

Tightening torque 14 Nm.

unscrew from brake caliper (31, 32, 33 and 34). Seal off connections immediately with blind plugs. Install only approved brake hoses (51). Do not install brake hoses (51) twisted. Re-route twisted brake hoses (51) correctly by changing position of hexagon on brake hose (51) in 12point retainer in retaining plate, see installation note. Install brake hose so that it cannot chafe. To check, turn steering wheel from left to right while fully compressing and rebounding the front axle half on each side. Similarly check routing of brake hose (51) of rear wheel brakes in upper and lower positions of the spring link. Tightening

Brake hose (51) to brake caliper (31, 32, 33 and 34) 18 Nm or

9-13 Nm on model 124,036 up to 01/93 and model 201.036 Evolution II ("Brembo" light alloy caliper).

Open box wrench (14 mm) 000 589 76 03 00, torque wrench 000 589 72 21 00.

Holders (52 and 59)

check correct position after accident repairs, see installation note.







Check position of brake hose following accident repairs, because even a minor change in the position of the holder (52) on the frame floor can change the brake hose position resulting in a chafed-through brake hose.




- Brake line

Brake hose installation note

When connecting ensure that the brake hose is not twisted. A minimum distance of 15 mm to other axle parts must be ensured in all driving situations.

A retaining plate (60) with 12-point retainer is fastened to the holder (52). Insert brake hose (51) into retaining plate (60) so that it does not chafe with the steering turned to the left and right lock and the suspension fully extended or retracted.

Note on disposal

Dispose of used brake fluid as polluting waste. (See disposal instructions in MBVD Environmental Protection Catalog Chapter 2.6 - pages 2–43). Brake fluid which does not contain oil can be recycled.

This requires that the brake fluid be collected and stored according to type.

For this purpose we recommend using the collection system from the Schröder company described in the MBVD Workshop Equipment Catalog under the following numbers:
