


# A. Removal, installation




Catch (1)	open, close.
Cover of fuse box (2)	take off, fit on.
Phillips screws (3)	unscrew, screw in.
Cover of relay box (4)	take off, fit on.
Phillips screw (5)	unscrew, screw in.
Fuse carrier (6)	take out, insert.
Fuse and relay box	press apart (arrow).
Relay holder (7)	take out, insert.


The catches (arrows) must be pressed in order to remove the couplings for the relays.



# B. Location of auxiliary fuse boxes




F12 Auxiliary fuse box, auxiliary heater (STH)







## C. General

A fuse holder with 4 fuses may be inserted additionally for certain optional equipment.




As of 07/86 vehicles with automatic climate control are fitted with an auxiliary fuse box (F15), automatic climate control (KLA)/automatic temperature control (TAU) blower motor, with a 30 A leaf fuse for the blower motor.

If, when working on the fuse and relay box on vehicles from start of production up to 06/86, it is found that the blower fuse (no. 12) has lowered, install the auxiliary fuse box (54–0180).



25 A fuses with solder point have been installed since 03/86.




# D. Replacing threaded sleeve

#### Note

The threaded sleeves for the rear securing screws of the relay box cover (arrows) can be replaced if the securing screws are tight and have to be drilled off.

### Scope of work

- 1 Remove cover from fuse box.
- 2 Remove securing screws.
- 3 Drill off head of tight screw(s) with 7 mm dia. drill.
- 4 Remove cover of relay box.
- 5 Carefully knock out damaged threaded sleeve(s) with a punch.
- 6 Coat new threaded sleeve(s) with Loctite and draw into the housing with a screw.
- 7 Fit on covers again.
