Note

When reeling up belt, noises on automatic reel are functional noises.

In the event of a complaint, excessive noises can be eliminated by replacing the seat belt. Never use oil or grease to eliminate noises.

Likewise, do not disassemble the automatic reel, since the preloaded spring may cause accidents. Automatic reel which have been opened are no longer recognized as a warranty case.

Complaint:

Buckle tongue on belt twisted

Fold belt as shown on illustration and pull buckle tongue over belt into normal position.


Modified rear safety belts were phased in starting in September 1990. When the belt is completely rolled up the buckle tongue on the modified rear seat belts is located directly above the seat cushion. This prevents the buckle tongue from getting into the wheelhouse. Moreover, the belt rolls up more easily.

If complaints are received regarding the way in which the rear seat belts roll up on vehicles produced earlier, proceed as follows:


Procedure

Check rear seat belts:

With the rear pillar trim installed pull buckle tongue down to seat cushion, then release; the seat belt should roll up automatically (arrow). If not, proceed as follows:





- 1 Remove trim on rear pillar (RI 68-449).
- 2 Measure gap between panel and bracket (nominal dimension: min. 1.7 mm), increase gap with plastic wedge, if required (arrow).
- 3 Check belt guide fitting for easy motion. If hard to move proceed with points 4 and 5 below.



Tightening torque: 35 ± 10 Nm


5 Check belt guide fitting for easy motion.





- 7 Reinstall rear pillar trim.



- 10 Press out and remove previous plastic rivet with plastic wedge.






Arrow = rotation lock Seat belt inertia roller
